
What is America's Great Loop?

What is America's Great Loop?

A series of 30, 50 or 100 mile day trips from one marina to the next or from one anchorage to another

You might be out of sight of land five times

- Gulf of Mexico
- Gulf stream to the Bahamas and return
- Lake Ontario
- Lake Michigan

You will be near an airport or car rental agency almost every day

There are approximately 250 boats traveling on the Loop annually.

Look for the AGLCA burgee for instant camaraderie.

White burgee – in progress
Gold burgee - completed one loop
Platinum burgee - completed two or more loops.

- •Understand the maintenance requirements and schedule. Oil and oil filters, fuel filters, transmission oil, zincs engine and shafts.
- •You will be in salt water. Type of bottom paint?


When should I depart for the Loop?

Your goal is to be chasing 80

If the temperature is forecast to be less than 80*f – move

Depart Lake Michigan mid-September and head south on the rivers





